1	Earth	The planet we all live on.	/urth/	The Earth is our big, blue and green home.
2	Sun	The big star that gives us light and warmth.	/sun/	The sun makes our planet warm.
3	Air	The clear stuff all around us that we breathe.	/air/	Clean air is important for our lungs.
4	Warm	Feeling a little hot, like on a nice day.	/wōrm/	The jacket kept me warm on the cool day.
5	Hot	Feeling a lot of heat, sometimes too much.	/hot/	The sand was too hot for bare feet.
6	Light	The energy from the sun or a lamp that helps us see.	/līt/	We use the natural light from the window.
7	Rain	Water falling from the clouds.	/rāne/	The rain helps all the flowers grow.
8	Cloud	A white or gray shape in the sky.	/klowd/	I saw a big, fluffy cloud that looked like a sheep.
9	Wind	Moving air that we can feel and that moves flags.	/wind/	The strong wind blew my hat away.
10	Ice	Water that has frozen and become hard.	/īs/	The polar bears walk on the ocean ice.
11	Water	What we drink, and what is in oceans and rivers.	/wah-tur/	We should save every drop of water.
12	Tree	A very tall, large plant with a woody trunk.	/tree/	A big tree gives us cool shade.
13	Plant	A living thing that grows in the soil.	/plant/	Every plant helps clean the air we breathe.
14	Grow	What plants and people do when they get bigger.	/grō/	We helped the garden grow big and strong.
15	Animal	A living creature that eats plants or other animals.	/an-ih-mul/	We must protect every kind of animal.
16	Home	The place where a person or animal lives.	/hōme/	The forest is the bear's home.
17	Ocean	The big, salty blue water.	/ō-shun/	The ocean is where the big whales swim.
18	Soil	The brown dirt or earth where plants grow.	/soyl/	We dug a hole in the soil to plant the tree.
19	Forest	A very big area of land covered with many trees.	/for-ist/	The deer live deep inside the green forest.
20	Seed	A tiny thing you put in the soil to grow a new plant.	/seed/	We put the seed in the dirt to grow a flower.
21	Trash	Things we throw away, like old wrappers.	/trash/	Put your trash in the correct garbage can.
22	Litter	Trash that is left on the ground.	/lit-ur/	We picked up all the litter in the park.
23	Dirty	Something that is not clean, like polluted water.	/dur-tee/	The water in the lake became dirty.
24	Clean	Something that is fresh and pure.	/kleen/	We want the world to stay clean.
25	Smoke	The gray stuff that comes from a fire or a chimney.	/smōke/	The factory smoke makes the air dirty.
26	Plastic	A material used for many things, but is bad for the ocean.	/plas-tik/	Try not to use too many plastic bags.
27	Waste	Anything that is not used and is thrown away.	/wāst/	Let's try to make less waste every day.
28	Gas	The stuff from cars and factories that warms the planet.	/gas/	The car's tailpipe lets out bad gas.
29	Harm	To hurt or damage something.	/hahrm/	We should never harm the little insects.
30	Spill	When a liquid like water or oil comes out by accident.	/spill/	The oil spill made the birds dirty.
31	Recycle	To take old things and turn them into new things.	/ree-sī-kul/	We always recycle our cans and paper.
32	Reuse	To use something again instead of throwing it away.	/ree-yūz/	You can reuse this jar to store your crayons.
33	Compost	To mix old food scraps to make good soil.	/kom-pōst/	Banana peels are good to put in the compost bin.
34	Save	To keep something so it is not wasted.	/sāve/	Remember to save water when you brush your teeth.
35	Turn Off	To stop the flow of light or water.	/turn off/	Please turn off the light when you leave the room.

36	Walk	To use your feet to go places instead of a car.	/wawk/	We should walk to the park to help the Earth.
37	Bicycle	A machine with wheels that you pedal.	/bī-sik-ul/	Riding my bicycle is good for the Earth.
38	Sun Power	Energy that comes from the sun.	/sun pow-ur/	The house uses sun power from the roof.
39	Wind Power	Energy that comes from moving air.	/wind pow-ur/	The big machine uses wind power to make light.
40	Protect	To keep something safe from harm.	/pruh-tekt/	We need to protect all the little sea animals.
41	Energy	The power we use to do work, like turn on a light.	/en-ur-jee/	We must not waste electric energy.
42	Safe	Not being in any danger or harm.	/sāfe/	We keep our planet safe by taking care of it.
43	Good	Something that is right and helpful for the Earth.	/gūūd/	Recycling cans is a good thing to do.
44	Bad	Something that is wrong and hurts the Earth.	/bad/	Cutting down too many trees is bad for the forest.
45	Care	To be kind to and watch over something.	/kair/	I will care for my new plant every day.
46	Future	The time that will happen after today.	/fyū-chur/	We are saving the Earth for our future.
47	Earth Day	A special day to celebrate and learn about the Earth.	/urth dā/	We plant a flower every year on Earth Day.
48	Overheat	To get much too hot.	/ō-vur-heet/	The planet will overheat if we make too much gas.
49	Healthy	Being strong and well, like a person or a planet.	/hel-thee/	We want a healthy planet for everyone.
50	Share	To let others use something, like a toy or a book.	/shair/	We can share books to save paper.
51	Flick	To quickly turn a switch on or off.	/flik/	You can flick the light switch off with one finger.
52	Bag	Something you use to carry things, like groceries.	/bag/	I use my cloth bag at the store instead of a paper one.
53	Bottle	A container for water or juice.	/bot-ul/	Use your own reusable water bottle every day.
54	Fix	To mend something that is broken.	/fiks/	We can fix the broken chair instead of throwing it away.
55	Share	To use something with others instead of each having a new one.	/shair/	We can share books with our friends.
56	Can	A container made of metal, good for recycling.	/kan/	Put your soda can in the blue bin.
57	Paper	What books and school worksheets are made of.	/pā-pur/	We must save lots of paper.
58	Reuse	To use an item again for a new purpose.	/ree-yūz/	Let's reuse this cardboard box for a fun fort.
59	Less	A smaller amount; doing things a little bit smaller.	/les/	Use less water when you wash your hands.
60	Fog	A thick cloud that forms very close to the ground.	/fog/	The fog was so thick

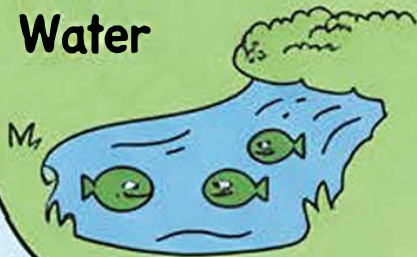

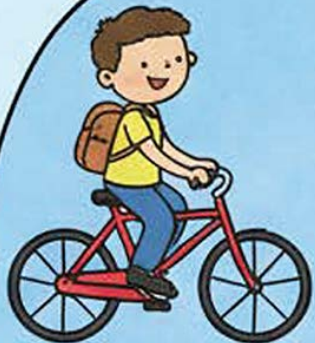
